Modification of Initial Application for Project Eligibility Letter

Dear Greg:

After thorough review of the comments submitted by the various Town boards, the applicant has revised the application. A major concern of the town was the affordability of the project as a whole. The town voiced concerns that the market rate units were not affordable. To address this financial viability, the applicant has revised the project as follows:

- 1) The revised proposed project will consist of forty (40) non-age restricted condominium units with four (4) age restricted units (55+) comprised of duplex unit type buildings with driveway, roadways and associated infrastructure. Thirty-nine (39) units will have 1 car garages with two (2) bedrooms. 11.4% of the units (5 units) will have 1 car garage and three (3) bedrooms.
- 2) The applicant will provide eleven (11) affordable units up from seven (7) affordable units.
- 3) The size of the units has decreased from approximately 2156 sq. ft. to 1250 to 1500 sq. ft. This reduction is sq. ft. has allowed the applicant to decrease the sales price range of a market rate units from \$669,000.00 to \$749,000.00 down to \$429,000.00 to \$449,000.00.
- 4) While the number of units has increased, the applicant revised the plan to eliminate all three (3) units from the front of the parcel. The revised application will have no units along Perkins Row. This will allow for an undisturbed scenic entrance.
- 5) The revised application also includes 1) snow areas, bus stop and play area for the homeowners.

Revised House Plans:

The proposed plan has incorporated safety, environmental and infrastructure parameters into the design. Extensive engineering by the applicant during the course of the ZBA process shall address any concerns that the ZBA or it's consultant will have. The houses in the development shall be smaller units on less acreage. This leads to a more affordable product for sale than the current houses available in Topsfield. An extensive presentation for the design review of the units will be submitted to the ZBA and will address final design of units.

Wetland Resource:

The order of conditions for the road under the wetlands protection act was extended by the commissioners until December 18, 2021 which has been duly recorded at the registry of deeds. The recommendations made by the Ipswich River Watershed Association letter will be examined for inclusion in overall planning of the Project.

Roadway Design:

The roadway design shall meet the standards for safe vehicle passage. This shall be shown through the traffic study and further engineering reports.

Parking:

The applicant provides the required parking spots as per ZBA bylaws with an additional 12 visitor parking spots.

Septic:

The response by the planning board is speculation. Final design of the septic system shall be submitted during the ZBA hearing process for approval.

Snow:

Snow areas have been provided on the engineering plans attached hereto.

Water:

The applicant shall complete the required testing and engineering to ensure enough flow for the development.

Electricity Supply:

The applicant has not been notified of any adequacy issues with the electrical supply to the site.

Traffic:

A traffic study shall be conducted and submitted by the applicant as pert of the ZBA hearing process. The traffic consultant expects minimal to no impact; Visibility along Perkins Row at

the site locus meets or exceeds site line specifications for traffic considerations; Limited tree removal is expected along Perkins Row which would not take away from its Scenic Road designation.

Stormwater Management:

Stormwater plans will be submitted with the ZBA application for peer review.

Conclusion:

The site is appropriate for this type of development and the Town of Topsfield would be well served by a development bringing additional affordable units to the community.

The applicant is encouraged, therefore, to make contact with the municipality prior to submitting the Site Approval application in order to ensure that the applicant understands any concerns that the municipality may be likely to raise regarding the proposed development.

In order for a project to receive Site Approval, MassHousing must determine that (i) the applicant has sufficient legal control of the site, (ii) the applicant is a public agency, non-profit organization or limited dividend organization, and (iii) the applicant and the project are generally eligible under the requirements of the MassHousing program selected by the applicant, subject to final eligibility review and approval. Furthermore, MassHousing must determine that the site of the proposed project is generally appropriate for residential development (taking into consideration municipal actions previously taken to meet affordable housing needs) and that the conceptual project design is generally appropriate for the site. Brief Project Description (150 words or less):

The proposed project will consist of 40 non-age restricted condominium units with 4 age restricted units (55+) comprised of duplex unit type buildings with driveway, roadways and associated infrastructure.

Access to the site will be provided by a 22 foot wide roadway from Perkins Row. The condominiums are designed by Philippe Thibault, AIA, the architect and are approximately 1250 - 1500 sq. ft. Thirty nine (39) units will have 1 car garages with two (2) bedrooms. 11.4% of the units (5 units) will have three bedrooms and 1 car garage.

The project will access the utility infrastructure located on Perkins Row, including water, electric, telephone and cable. There will be a private septic system for the units. The storm-water management system will be designed to fully comply with all the standards of the MA DEP Storm-water Management Regulations.

The applicant is proposing that twenty five (25%) percent, or eleven units will be identified as affordable units and will blend into the proposed market rate homes and will be evenly distributed throughout the development.

ARCHITECURAL NARRATIVE MEMORANDUM

Preliminary Project Narrative - Perkins Landing - Perkins Row, Topsfield

The proposed buildings are designed with pitched roofs that are no more than two and one-half stories duplex style units. The units will typically be 2 bedrooms with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ bathrooms.

The garage is integrated into the front elevation to provide an ease of access while minimizing the need for excessive paved surfaces. The scale of the garage is visually reduced with the layering of roof lines on the front elevation of the homes. The second story front bedroom dormers are designed with gables facing the street presenting a varied second story roofline that is integrated with simpler shed roofs. The architect will present modified front elevations during the design review period.

The rear elevations are a combination of one-story facades with second story shed dormers facing the back of the building and modest upper shed dormers providing an additional second floor bedroom on select units. Each of the first floors will have nine-foot ceiling height with standard ceiling heights on the second floor.

Exterior finish materials shall be selected from a variety of decay and weather resistant products like vinyl siding and PVC trim. These materials are common, readily available residential materials providing durability and longevity in the local climate; thereby reducing maintenance expense. To give the project some variety, the installed vinyl siding may vary slightly in color (simple earth tones of green, blue, grey or tan). The trim will be typical PVC or equivalent for rakes, casings, fascia and etc. Roofing will be a single color (grey tone) of 30-year architectural asphalt shingles typical throughout. Windows will be Pella, white, weather resistant double hung fenestrations, assorted casements and awnings as specified to blend with the continuity and character of the development. Foundations will be concrete but reduced as low as feasible to the grade to minimize visual appearance. Entry porches will be stone or a similar cultured product and exterior columns, decks and railings will be a combination of pressure treated wood and/or composite materials for increased durability and longevity of appearance. The patios shall be permeable pavers. Patios will be provided as preferred on grade landscape features. All homes will have similar aluminum gutters and downspout rain leaders into grade to reduce sheet run off.

All Perkins Landing homes will be energy star certified. Ratings will be provided by certified home energy rating professionals following review. The homes will be insulated with spray foam insulation, typical throughout and will conform to all requirements for air and moisture barriers per local code regulations. Air exchange and lighting energy requirements as applicable will be met.

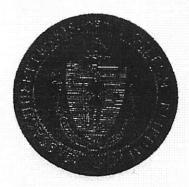

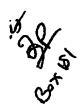
