#### **NEW BUSINESS**

<u>Presentation by Monica Lamboy and Anthony J. Torrisi from the Edward J. Collins</u>
Jr. Center at the University of Massachusetts/Boston

Town Administrator Kellie Hebert gave a description of the Town's collaboration with the Collins Center, focusing on long term planning for financial resources,

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financial forecast and best practices. This has been funded by a \$35,000 Community Compact grant.

Ms. Hebert then introduced Monica Lamboy and Anthony J. Torrisi from The Collins Center.

Ms. Lamboy and Mr. Torrisi presented their draft Comprehensive Management Financial Management Policies and Guidelines for the Town of Topsfield to the Selectmen including:
