Chairman Powers called the meeting to order at 5:30PM. Board members present in addition to Chairman Laura Powers, were Selectmen Martha Morrison (left at 8PM), Boyd Jackson, Steve Lais and Eldon Goodhue. Of the Selectmen's staff, Town Administrator Kellie Hebert and Board Executive Assistant Donna Rich were in attendance. The Board discussed items to be worked on as goals for FY16. They eliminated items that might not be achievable by the Board at this time.

- Develop a Plan for Facilities Management; Take a plan for Town Hall to Town Meeting to be discussed at a Working Session in September. This would also include electronic document storage.
- Succession planning for upcoming retirees to be discussed at Town Hall at a Working Session in September.
- Develop financial planning policies which would include debt and capital to be discussed at a Working Session in October.
- Develop policy and procedures to identify and clarify the roles and responsibilities of the Board of Selectmen and the Town Administrator.

At 8:36 PM, Selectmen Goodhue made a motion to adjourn and Selectman Lais seconded the motion; so voted: 4-0.
