Safe environmental methods are very important when it comes to irrigation and other landscaping practices. The Greenscapes Massachusetts program is designed to help inform citizens of ways that they can have beautiful landscapes that protect water. "Greenscaping" helps preserve water for drinking and maintaining sustainable water levels in streams, rivers, and wetlands. Chemicals that are in fertilizers, insecticides, herbicides, and fungicides can contaminate drinking water or cause rapid algae growth through stormwater runoff or groundwater.
