Topsfield Conservation Commission Minutes of Meeting June 26, 2019

Cheryl Jolley, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. with a quorum present. She announced that the meeting was being audio recorded.

HEARINGS:

NoI 307-0775: 4 Glen Road (Map 32, Lot 134), Allan/Williams & Sparages - raze existing and construct new garage, remove trees, improve existing gravel driveway

Luther read the legal notice and proof of abutter notice was submitted.

Greg Hochmuth presented on behalf of the applicants, Michael Allan and Beth Roberto. The proposed projects are to raze an existing garage and rebuild a new garage within the same footprint, provide required compensatory flood storage, remove 6 large pine trees, and expand and pave the driveway. Hochmuth provided an overview of the characteristics of the property and the buildings. He noted two conservation posts installed under an OOC for septic repair in the back of the house. All of the proposed work is in the front. The entire lot is in a flood plain.

The proposed new garage will be within the same footprint as the existing garage but will have less of an overhang which would reduce the amount of roof runoff. Discussion was held on the alternative locations for a new garage. Hochmuth stated that moving the structure to a different location would fill more flood plain.

The proposal includes the removal of 6 large pine trees with the replanting of a different species of trees and shrubs. Hochmuth stated that he felt the area where the large pines are now will not accommodate 6 new trees. Betts suggested that along with trees, a denser planting of shrubs should be done in that area.

The driveway would be expanded by cutting approximately 6 feet into the hill along the side of the driveway, this will also provide some of the compensatory flood storage area. This would change the grade of the slope but no more than 3:1. The proposal includes paving the driveway. The existing

driveway is hard packed gravel and is not pervious. Discussion was held on the installation of a gravel trench for infiltration of driveway run off and the installation of a drip trench behind the garage. Betts discussed the infiltration relative to the water table.

Hochmuth requested a continuance to develop a planting plan and a drainage plan.

Gaffney commented on the two ponds and stream on the property. She suggested that the homeowner allow the TCC to assess it for vernal pools.

Luther moved to continue the hearing until July 17, 2019, at the request of the applicant. Shamroth seconded and the vote was unanimous in favor.

Continuation RDA 2019-07: 8 Coppermine Road (Map 79, Lot 002), Ypsilantis – tree, vine, shrub removal, landscaping, install shed

Jolley noted that the hearing has been continued several times. TCC members felt the landscaping plan submitted was too vague to consider for approval. Jolley clarified for the applicant that a RDA hearing would result in either a negative or positive determination of applicability, or the applicant could withdraw the application and re-apply when landscaping plans have detailed information and a location for the shed has been determined.

Luther explained that with a steep slope into the wetland, erosion control in that area is the main issue. The TCC suggested that the applicant consult a wetland scientist or engineer to develop a plan that would address the pertinent issues and that a final decision be made on the location of the shed.

The applicant requested a continuance.

Luther moved to continue the hearing for RDA 2019-07 to July 17, 2019 at the request of the applicant. Shamroth seconded and the vote was unanimous in favor.

Continuation NoI 307-0774: 22 Boardman Lane (Map 18, Lot 038), Tatum – tree and invasive plant removal, replanting

The applicants were not in attendance but had submitted to Gaffney a revised project narrative memo dated 6/24/19 and the revised planting plan with additional plants and includes a fast growing meadow mix to stabilize the soils quickly. The TCC agreed that this mix would be good for erosion control. Discussion was held on the timeframe of the invasive plant removal, soil replacement and replanting. The TCC recommended that the applicants work with and have the approval of Gaffney prior to commencing with each stage of the project.

Luther moved to close the hearing for Notice of Intent 307-0774: 22 Boardman Lane. Shamroth seconded and the vote was unanimous in favor.

Luther moved to approve the project proposed in Notice of Intent 307-0774 for tree and invasive plant removal and the replanting of the site according to the specifications in the plan titled "Tatum Residence, 22 Boardman Lane, Topsfield MA 01983" dated 6/19/2018 [incorrect year noted on the plan and should read 6/19/2019], prepared by Corliss Landscape & Irrigation. In addition, all activities will require approval from the Conservation Administrator prior to commencing work and all plantings

will require a two year monitoring with annual report submitted. Shamroth seconded and the vote was unanimous in favor.

Gaffney reviewed the details of the Enforcement Order issued for unauthorized tree removal and disturbance of vegetation and soil. Delineation is required with a site visit following delineation and then restoration.

Luther moved to ratify Enforcement Order 2019-04 for 84 Perkins Row. Shamroth seconded and the vote was unanimous in favor.
