## Significant Structure/Demolition Delay Review

The purpose of Topsfield's Demolition Delay By-law (Chapter XXVI) is to preserve, protect, and document significant buildings and structures within Topsfield that are outside Local Historic Districts or that are on the Historic Buildings List. Such buildings and structures reflect distinctive features of the architectural, cultural, economic, agricultural landscape or social history of the Town, and their preservation promotes the public welfare by making the Town a more attractive and desirable place to live and work. If the Applicant's project is within the Historic District, the Certificate of Appropriateness process applies.

The intent of the By-law is not to permanently prevent demolition of buildings or their features, but rather through the six-month delay, to provide an opportunity to develop preservation solutions minimizing the loss of historic buildings and fabric. The Historic Commission ("the Commission") wishes to encourage and assist owners and townspeople at a minimum to seek alternatives to replacing windows, doors, trim and other original architectural features and at a maximum to seek out persons who might be willing to purchase, preserve, rehabilitate, restore or relocate structures rather than demolish them, and thus limiting the detrimental effect of demolition on the historical architectural resources of the Town. In addition, this delay will give the Commission an opportunity to document historic or important architectural resources before they are lost from Topsfield's cultural landscape.

To achieve these purposes, the Commission is empowered to advise the Building Inspector with respect to the issuance of permits for demolition of significant structures and their elements, and where appropriate and consistent with the intent and purpose of this By-law, to allow demolition under conditions designed to minimize the loss of distinctive features of significant structures. When an applicant files and application for demolition with the Inspector of Buildings, a denial will be issued and the applicant instructed to fill out the Historic Commissions Application for Significant Structure Review.
