




## **Young Entrepreneur Guidelines**

Topsfield Recreation is collaborating with the Tri-Town Council to welcome Young Entrepreneurs to participate at this years HomeGrown Markets! Outlined below are all of the participation guidelines and market information.

The goal of including Young Entrepreneurs is to provide a platform to sell products they craft on their own and learn important skills around business, money, marketing, social and communication skills. It also helps youth build self-confidence, independence, enhances creative thinking, problem solving, and learn how to give back to the community.

## **HomeGrown Market Details**

What is the HGM?	HGM is an outdoor market, organized by Topsfield Recreation, for
	local businesses/entrepreneurs who may utilize local ingredients,
	grow their own produce/herbs, handcraft the products they make,
	etc. and give them an opportunity to promote what they have to
	offer. We are focusing on Topsfield or North Shore businesses
	which adds to our "home grown" theme. We think of the North
	Shore as our backyard and there are so many wonderful small
	businesses and talented individuals who deserve to show off these
	talents and thrive! Live music, food trucks, beer or wine tasting,
	and other activities will take place as well.
Location	Topsfield Town Common (with the flag pole and gazebo)
Dates	HGM is held on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month from June-
	September.
Hours &	Markets are held from 5:00-7:00 PM and open to the public.
Setup/Breakdown	Before each market an email is sent to all vendors to notify you
	about the allowable setup arrival time and details pertaining to that
	market. We do NOT provide tables/chairs/tents. You must bring
	everything you need to display/sell your products. Vendors are
	expected to stay until 7:00PM.
What else to expect	At each market we also have live music/or music via a PA system,
	lawn games, food/beverage truck(s), and other various activities
	that are scheduled or provided by other vendors.
Mission	The mission of the HomeGrown Market is to provide the Topsfield
	community a series of family friendly events that emphasize
	supporting local; While offering the opportunity for Topsfield and
	North Shore farmers, gardeners, artisans, creators, performers,
	musicians, nonprofits, young entrepreneurs, and local businesses to
	showcase their product, and/or talents, in a welcoming and
	organized community-based marketing alternative.

## **Vendor Participation Details**

Ages Accepted	9-17 years old
	Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult at all
	times.
Vendor Fee	In lieu of a vendor fee, we ask all Young Entrepreneurs to donate 10%
	of your profits to a non-profit of your choice.
	(10% of total profits from all markets you participated in)
Acceptance	Space is limited, by age as well as product type. Items being sold
	must be handmade or grown by the applicant, of high quality and
	appropriate for sale at a public event. Applications will be reviewed
	and must be approved before acceptance. The goal is to provide a
	wide range of vendors and ages. Table sharing is not permitted. If
	your product contains anything edible you must contact the Topsfield
	Board of Health regarding preparation and permitting. Please note
	that additional fees from the BOH may apply.
Vendor Space	Vendor spaces will not be reserved until the application has been
	received, and you have been contacted confirming your participation.
	Vendor spaces will be assigned by the Recreation Department in
	advance and you will be directed to your spot upon check-in. Table
	sharing is not permitted. It is up to the vendor to bring his/her own
	table, chairs, and anything else needed for your display and sales.
	You are welcome to bring a canopy as the market is held outside. All
	vendors must have their display broken down and cleared by 8PM.
	Vendors are responsible for their own display, setup, and breakdown.
	We are not responsible for items left behind. No open flames.
	Electricity is available, but you must provide your own extension
	cord.
Preparation Seminar	The Tri-Town Council will be offering a zoom seminar to all
via Zoom	participating Young Entrepreneurs to offer preparation advice, selling
	tips, what you should bring the day of, and more. We highly suggest
	you attend as this is also a great time to ask lots of questions!
