April 22, 2019

BUDGET UPDATES:

- **Override Ballot Question**: Prop 2 ½ Override of \$593K on Election ballot for vote.
- **FY19 Budget Review**: Members of Financial Management team and Department heads are conducting full reviews of FY19 department budgets for STM Budget Transfers.
- **Health Insurance**: FY20 Health Insurance Premiums to be reduced by 7% in FY20 new premiums will begin in June for July 1st coverage. Despite premium reductions, Finance Team recommends a level-funded budget to ensure adequate funding in casse any new employee headcount is added in FY20 due to attrition, new hires, override passage, etc. The initial budget projection for Health Insurance was \$135K higher at time of budget request in January; The Level funding recommendation keeps line at \$2.1M for FY20.
