I, Officer Levasseur, report the following:

On Saturday, 10/07/23, I worked my assigned 3:00PM to 11:00PM shift in marked cruiser 12. My partners for the shift were Lt. Frost, Ofc. Lippi and Ofc. O'Donnell.

At approximately 9:30PM, the resident of 30 English Commons, identified as Thomas Kilduff, called to file a noise complaint against the wedding venue Connemara Farms located at 262 Rowley Bridge Road. Mr. Kilduff's property abuts 262 Rowley Bridge Road, along with multiple other residences in English Commons. This was Mr. Kilduff's second call regarding the excessive noise on this evening. Topsfield Police is familiar with the ongoing noise issues from Connemara Farms.

After Mr. Kilduff's first call, the noise not was not deemed excessive. Lt. Frost and Ofc. O'Donnell responded. I responded to the second call. I advised the RECC I would speak with Mr. Kilduff as I have spoken with him regarding the same issue in the past. Upon my arrival, I walked between the residences. I could hear the pounding of the drums, a guitar, and vocals from a what sounded like a live band. At this point, I deemed the noise to be excessive. The residents of #32 and #8 English Commons also called to complain while I was on scene.

I spoke with Mr. Kilduff. I could hear the music as I spoke with him. He stated the noise from the drums was extremely annoying for him and his family. I asked him if there had been any progress with Town management regarding stipulations to the noise. He stated the Chairman of the Topsfield Board of Zoning created new stipulations for Connemara Farms but it appeared they were not complying. I advised Mr. Kilduff I would document this incident.
